


TURKISH DIPLOMATIC ARCHIVES



100 years of history, 65 million pages at one digital address

Accesible, Secure, Transparent

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey is carrying out the most comprehensive archiving project in the history of the Republic. Around 65 million pages are being digitalized and indexed.

Diplomatic documents that are of crucial importance for truthful writing of the history of Turkey's foreign policy, are becoming accessible after years of meticulos work.

A Historic Milestone

Turkish Diplomatic Archives (TDA) includes documents from the years 1919-2001. It will be digitaly avaible to researchers through the "Researchers Interface" as an easy and rapidly accessible site.

A New Source for Researchers

The TDA includes treaties and documents of a long period in history, in Turkish, English, French and others, including 500 thousand pages in Ottoman Turkish.

The TDA will provide precious content for researchers and will be an essential resource for the academia.

E-Publications and the TDA web site

TDA web site <u>www.diad.mfa.gov.tr</u> will be available in 2019.

Researchers will be able to connect to the «Researchers Interface» through the TDA web site.

New publications will be available as e-publications. After digitalization former publications of the MFA will also be available for downloading.
